Anmerkungen des Herausgebers

Die hier vorgelegte Edition versteht sich als *praktische Ausgabe*. Artikulation, Dynamik und Notenlängen sind der vertrauten Lesart unserer traditionellen Sinfonieorchester angepasst worden. Wer die Ergänzungen anhand des Urtextes überprüfen will, kann dies mühelos mit der allgemein zugänglichen kritischen Ausgabe der "Rosamunde" Partitur und den sorgfältig herausgegebenen Fragmenten zum Scherzo vornehmen, da für die gesamte Rekonstruktion der verlorenen Teile ausschließlich Material hieraus verwendet wurde. Die Materialfülle erlaubte sogar, das Scherzo mit zwei Trios zu versehen.

Eine Aufführung der komplettierten Sinfonie gelingt überzeugender, wenn auch der erste Satz - dem Modell der *Eroica* folgend - als schneller Kopfsatz "in moderaten Eins" musiziert wird.

Das Aufführungsmaterial des Scherzos und des Finales kann beim Herausgeber bezogen werden.


